Decided also that Bro. and Sr. W.O. Winger move to Mtshabazi to take charge of the Girls' school and the work at that place,

Decided also that Brother A.C. Winger come to Matopo to take Bro. W.O. Winger's place. The above arrangements to be subject to the F.M. Board.
