The Missionaries of Matope, Mapane, and Mtshabazi Missions met in Conference at Mapane Monday, Aug. 14, 1911. Eld. H.P. Steigerwald presiding, H.J. Frey, Secretary. After prayer, the following articles were considered.

Art. I

What arrangements shall be made for a uniform allowance to be made to our native teachers?

Decided that the hired native teachers shall be paid one pound pr. month while engaged in teaching, and further that the teachers who are required to pay rent to land owners, shall have their rent paid.

Art. II

Whereas Sr. Elizabeth Engle has been on the field for four consecutive years,

Resolved that she should take a furlough near the coast as soon as arrangements can be made.

Art. III

Whereas, Bro. and Sr. Doner are leaving Mapane Mission, what arrangements shall be made for its supervision?

Decided that the same shall be under the oversight of the Matope Mission, which shall have the privilege of calling on the workers of Mtshabazi when necessary.
